JUNE 6, 2010 – MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend the Church celebrates the feast of the Body and Blood of Christ. The Gospel reading for this Sunday is the multiplication of the loaves from the Gospel of Luke. Luke brings out the Eucharistic implication of the multiplication of the loaves by the words he uses to describe it. Luke uses the same words that Jesus used at the institution of the Eucharist during the last supper...took, blessed, broke, gave. In the Eucharistic celebration the Church continues the mission of Jesus to teach, to heal and to nourish the community of the faithful.

Fr. Tom Moran will be leaving his residence at OLW for St. Charles in San Carlos on Tuesday, June 29, 2010. There will be a farewell reception for him after the 5:15 pm Saturday evening Mass, June 26, and after the 9:30 am Sunday Mass on June 27, 2010 at OLW.
